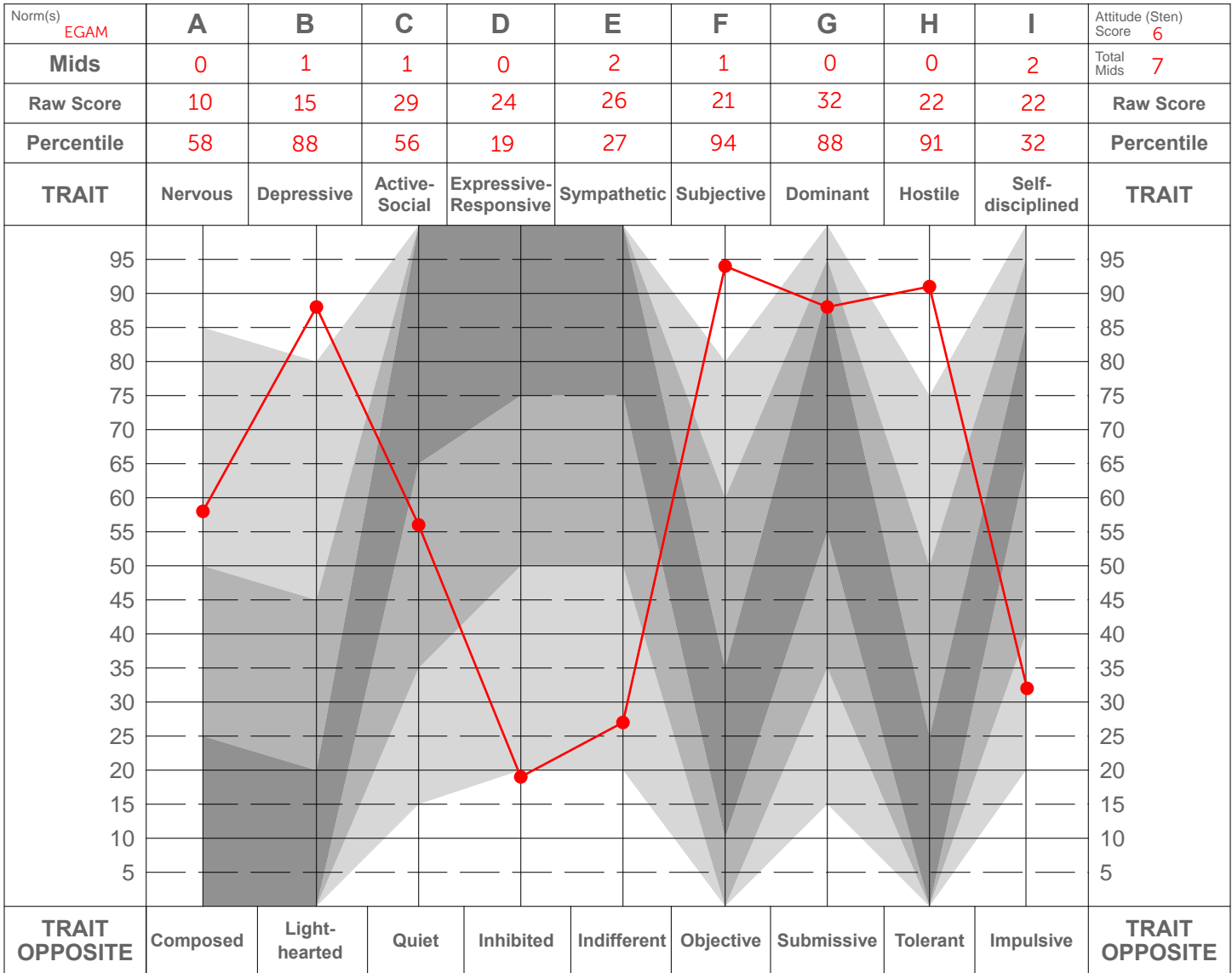


Taylor-Johnson Temperament Analysis®(T-JTA®) Shaded Profile
